

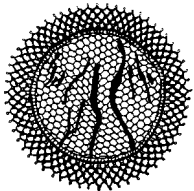
The *Finger Lakes Lace Guild* is a membership association founded in 1981 by people who study, make, design, collect, preserve or appreciate lace, and who educate themselves and others about lace, its identification, techniques, design, history, and preservation.

Guild meetings are open to the public and are held the third Sunday of each month (except June & Oct.) in the TC3 Conference Room at the Tompkins County Airport, off Warren Rd., Ithaca, NY from 1:30-4:30 pm. Information is available regarding lace lessons and supplies.

The *Finger Lakes Lace Guild* is available for demonstrations at historic, educational or civic events, fairs and festivals.

An annual LACE DAY is held each fall at the Ramada Inn, Triphammer Rd. at Route 13, Ithaca, NY, usually on Columbus Day weekend.
